With 'De Schaal van M', Mediawijs and Ketnet challenge 10- to 12-year-old pupils and their class with an online media literacy contest. The contest covers topics such as digital citizenship, artificial intelligence, online responding & netiquette, online shopping and the influences of the internet.

+ DSVM in the Classroom

Every day of that week, the children will watch an online episode of the popular Ketnet children's series 'United' in the classroom. In addition, they will participate in a daily quiz and an interesting debate on the theme covered in that episode. Classes will challenge each other with the Week Challenge! In that challenge, the goal is to collect 5 stars by the end of the week, which earns them the honorary title of '5-star class'. 5-star classes have a chance to win one of the 20 prizes.

+ DSVM at home

If your child logs on to the 'De Schaal van M' website at home, they can also light up the digital lights to see how far it has progressed in the contest. To do this, your child logs in via LeerID, an application of the Flemish Government.

Step 1: Log in as a student with the LeerID.

Through the Flemish Government login page that opens automatically.

Step 2: Add the class code to link your child to the class.
